## **Getting Started**





#### On/Off button

Press for 1 second to turn on or off

- Green The device is on
- Flashing Power saving mode
- Amber Low battery





#### 'Start'

Begin scanning

'Start + Patient'

Enter patient details before scanning

'Review'

Review previous scans

## Scanning





#### **Positioning**

The probe position is displayed in blue.

### Help Button

Using the help button

will give more scanning instructions.





#### **Use of Probe**

Apply gel. Place the probe 1cm above the pubic bone with silver orientation dots toward the patient's right hand side.

Angle 10 degrees toward the patient's feet. Scan from the bottom to the top of the bladder.

# Scanning





#### Record the Scan

To begin scanning, press the scan button scanning on either the probe or display.

Once you have obtained the largest volume, press the scan button  $\begin{tabular}{l} \put(0,0){\line(0,0){100}} \put(0,0){\li$

#### Reading the Scan

The bladder will be outlined as you scan.

The volume measurement is automatically updated as you scan and is located in the bottom left corner of the display.

This measurement may be repeated as needed by pressing the scan button again.

## Save Scan

Select the button to save, end and close the scan.

### **Second Scan**

Select the to perform a second scan in the vertical orientation for improved accuracy. Image two is a combined volume of both images.





### Review

Select the to review previous images of the current patient.

To view previous patient examinations from the home screen, select the 'Review' button.
